



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CCWEL SECTION 3 Q4) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/196


THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (CCWEL Section 3 Q4) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Twenty-seventh day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Sixteenth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicles” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate public realm works, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works), drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **North St Andrew Lane**, in its entirety.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of St Andrew Square.
