THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MARCHHALL CRESCENT) (NO. 2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/198

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Marchhall Crescent) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Twenty-eighth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Ninth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate Scottish Water lead replacement works, (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall: -
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of **Marchhall Crescent**, between the projected north gable end of No. 2 Marchhall Crescent and the projected south gable end of No. 8 Marchhall Crescent.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Kilmaurs Terrace and Marchhall Place, Edinburgh) (One-way) Traffic Regulation Order 2001’ will be suspended for the duration of this Order on **Marchhall Place**, to allow two-way traffic.

7. Access for through vehicular traffic in respect to the closure will be by way of Marchhall Crescent, Priestfield Road, Dalkeith Road and Marchhall Place. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
