THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (FERRY ROAD (SERVICE ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/203

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Ferry Road (service road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Twelfth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-third day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe working area for Scottish Water repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on

both sides of **Ferry Road** (service road – access to Nos. 500 – 535 Ferry Road), from the projected west gable end of No. 535 Ferry Road, eastwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
- 5. Access for through vehicular traffic in respect to the closure will be by way of Ferry Road and Pilton Drive.
