THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (COLINTON ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/38

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Colinton Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the Twenty-seventh day of February Two thousand and twenty-three and shall remain in force up to and including the Nineteenth day of May Two thousand and twenty-three.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in the 1984 Act;
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate Scottish Water mains repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on *both sides* of **Colinton Road**, from a point 5 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Craiglockhart Park, southwards to a point 5 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Craiglockhart Road.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
- 5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3 of this Order.
