



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MAYFIELD ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/79

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL, in exercise of powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Mayfield Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023” and shall come into operation on the First day of May Two thousand and twenty-three and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirtieth day of April Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
"Article" means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act; and;
"vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe loading area for the adjacent construction site (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall, drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven **Mayfield Road**, from a point 180 metres or thereby north of Liberton Road, southwards to its junction with Liberton Road, otherwise than in a *southbound* direction.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *one-way restriction* will be by way of Liberton Road, Gordon Terrace, Esslemont Road & Mayfield Road.
6. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
