THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BANKHEAD AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/143

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Bankhead Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect from the Third day of July Two thousand and twenty-three up to and including the Thirty-first day of August Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate SGN gas main installation works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time of *both sides* of (i) **Bankhead Broadway**, from its junction with Bankhead Medway, southwards to a point 10 metres or thereby south of its junction with Bankhead Terrace; (ii) **Bankhead Medway**, between its junction with Bankhead Place and its junction with Bankhead Broadway; and (iii) **Bankhead Terrace**: (1) from its junction Bankhead Broadway, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; and (2) from its junction with Bankhead Broadway, westwards for a distance of 125 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions described in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: (i) **Bankhead Broadway** and (iii) **Bankhead Terrace** – Bankhead Medway, Bankhead Avenue, Bankhead Crossway South, Bankhead Drive and Bankhead Crossway North; and (ii) **Bankhead Medway** – Bankhead Broadway, Bankhead Terrace, Bankhead Avenue and Bankhead Crossway North.
