THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CASTLE CONCERTS) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/157


THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Roads Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Castle Concerts) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “authorised event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by the City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event that can, upon request, provide a valid accredited pass associated with the Castle Concerts events for the duration of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - “pass” means an official pass issued by the City of Edinburgh Council’s representatives for the purpose of this Order;
 - “resident” means someone who, for the purposes of this Order, is currently residing in Mound Place or St Giles’ Street;
 - “road” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the 1984 Act and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this Order, includes part of a road;
 - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
 - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.

(b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of concerts at Edinburgh Castle (as signed as affected by the events), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads described in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads described in Schedule 2 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.

4. Nothing in:
 - (a) Article 3 of this Order shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
 - (b) Article 3(b) of this Order shall apply to *authorised event vehicles* on the specific sections on **Johnston Terrace** and **St Giles' Street** described in Schedule 2;
 - (c) Article 3(b) of this Order shall apply to *resident permit parking bays* on the sections of **Mound Place** and **St Giles' Street** described in Schedule 2; and
 - (d) Article 3(b) of this Order shall apply to *enterprise car club bays* on the section of **St Giles' Street** described in Schedule 2.
5. Nothing in Article 3(b) shall apply:-
 - a. to motor vehicles being driven or used by disabled persons and which conspicuously display, so as to be clearly visible from the front of the vehicle, a valid disabled person's badge; and
 - b. so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait while the vehicle is in actual use for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or while loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjoining the said road; provided that:
 - (i) no such vehicle so engaged shall wait for a period of more than thirty minutes in the same place; and
 - (ii) no such vehicle so engaged shall return to the same place, unless a period of more than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination of the previous waiting period.
6. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Castlehill) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023' will be suspended for the duration of this Order, to facilitate the holding of the Castle Concert events.
7. The 2018 Order shall be suspended on the affected sections of roads described in Schedule 2, during the hours and on the dates specified in the said Schedule.
8. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Castle Terrace, Lady Lawson Street, Lauriston Place, Forrest Road, Bristo Place, Teviot Place and George IV Bridge.

SCHEDULE 1
ROAD CLOSURES

(A) from 07:00 hours on 30/06/2023 to 01:00 hours on 17/07/2023 on:

(i) **Castlehill**; (ii) **Ramsay Lane**; (iii) **Ramsay Garden**; and (iv) **Mound Place**.

(B) from 16:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 05/07/2023, 06/07/2023, 07/07/2023, 08/07/2023, 09/07/2023 and 13/07/2023 on:

(i) **Johnston Terrace**; (ii) **Lawnmarket**, between its junction with Castlehill and its junction with George IV Bridge; (iii) **Castle Wynd North Steps**; and (iv) **Upper Bow**.

SCHEDULE 2
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

(A) from 07:00 hours on 30/06/2023 to 07:00 hours on 17/07/2023 on:

Johnston Terrace, south side: (1) from a point 33 metres or thereby south-west of the extended west kerbline of West Bow, south-westwards for a distance of 53 metres or thereby (*except authorised event vehicles*); and (2) from a point 184 metres or thereby south-west of the extended west kerbline of West Bow, south-westwards for a distance of 125 metres or thereby (*except authorised event vehicles*).

(B) from 15:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 05/07/2023, 06/07/2023, 07/07/2023, 08/07/2023, 09/07/2023 and 13/07/2023 on:

Johnston Terrace, north side, from a point 27 metres or thereby south-west of its junction with Lawnmarket, south-westwards for a distance of 48 metres or thereby.

(C) from 07:00 hours on 30/06/2023 to 07:00 hours on 17/07/2023 on:

Johnston Terrace, north side, from a point 236 metres or thereby north-east of the extended north kerbline of Castle Terrace, north-eastwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby (*except authorised event vehicles*).

(D) from 16:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 05/07/2023, 06/07/2023, 07/07/2023, 08/07/2023, 09/07/2023 and 13/07/2023 on:

(i) **Castlehill**; (ii) **Ramsay Lane**; (iii) **Ramsay Garden**; (iv) **Mound Place**: (1) **north side**, in its entirety; and (2) **south side**, from a point 21 metres or thereby west of its junction with North Bank Street, westwards to the point it adjoins Ramsay Lane (*except resident permit parking bays*); (v) **Lawnmarket, both sides**, between its junction with Castlehill and its junction with George IV Bridge; and (vi) **Upper Bow**.

(E) from 16:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 06/07/2023, 07/07/2023, 08/07/2023, 09/07/2023 and 13/07/2023 on:

St Giles' Street (*except resident permit parking bays, Enterprise Car Club bays, blue badge holder bays and authorised event vehicles*).
