THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (LAVEROCKBANK ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/163

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Laverockbank Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023” and shall come into operation on the Twenty-fourth day of July Two thousand and twenty-three and shall remain in force up to and including Thirty-first day of May Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate safe site access at No. 20 Laverockbank Road (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **Laverockbank Road, both sides**, from its junction with East Trinity Road, northwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3 of this Order.
