Thank you for expressing interest in the Corstorphine Connections project. We want to create safer and more comfortable conditions for walking, wheeling and cycling and a more attractive street environment where residents can spend time in their local streets and outdoor spaces.

Phase 1 implementation – week commencing 8 May – 24 May 2023

We are pleased to confirm that the completion of the implementation of phase 1 of the project will take place from week commencing 8 May and is planned to complete on 24 May 2023:

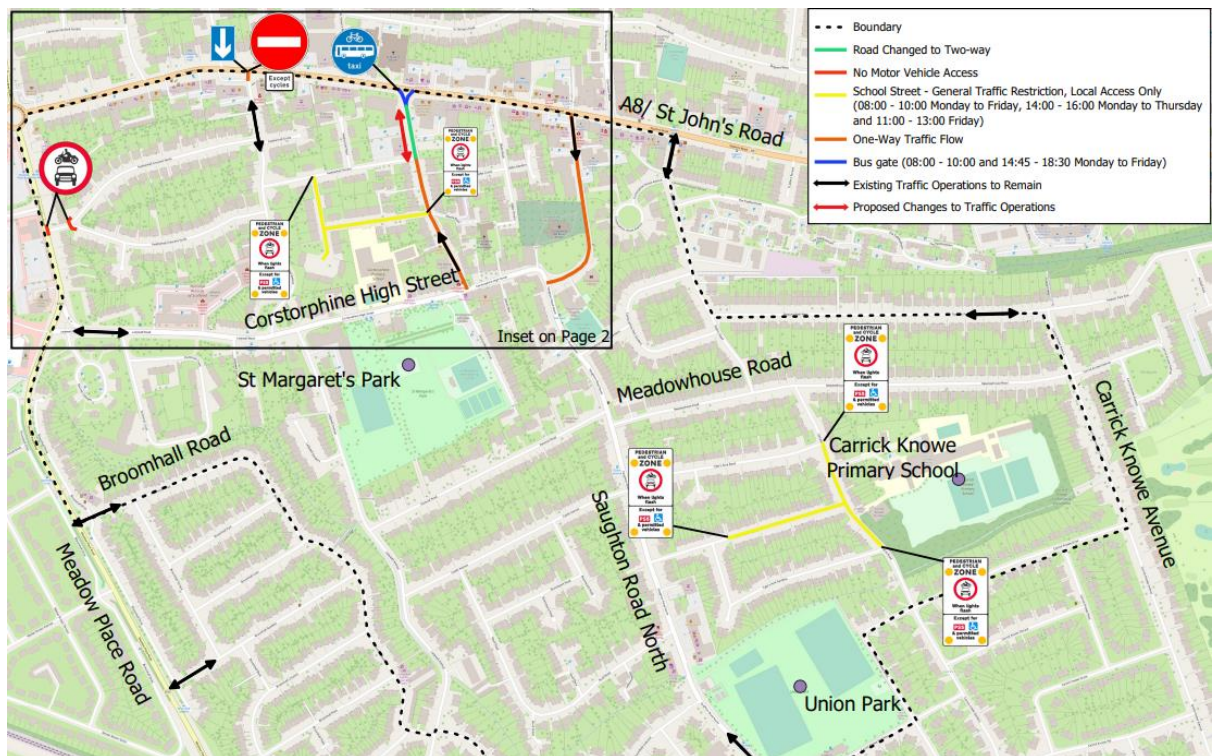
The changes to be introduced as part of the phase 1 implementation include (also see map below):

- A no entry north bound on Featherhall Avenue at the junction with St John's Road
- Bus gate on Manse Road, at the junction with St John's Road. Operational Mon-Fri 8:00-10:00 & 14:45-18:30
- Kirk Loan – bollard protection from pavement parking
- Featherhall Crescent – implementation of pencil bollards replacing existing temporary cones at junction with Meadow Place Road



Traffic operations

All properties will still be able to be accessed by motor vehicle. Our Traffic Operations Plan below shows where there may be changes to how you access properties or businesses within the area.



Work already completed

The project has already completed aspects of phase one which have increased planting, seating and safer spaces around the local primary schools in the local area as well as removing non-local through traffic from key areas.



Phase 2 implementation – footway widening – Summer 2023

Phase two will see footway widening and crossing improvements introduced and is currently planned to start in Summer 2023. These works will make it easier for people walking in the area and address some of the issues with narrow and sub-standard footways on key streets. Footways to be improved include:

- Corstorphine High Street
- Junction of Featherhall Terrace at Featherhall Avenue
- Junction of Kirk Loan at Saughton Road North
- Junction of Dovecot Road at Ladywell Avenue
- Junction of Featherhall Avenue at Ladywell Road

- Saughton Road North around the shops near Union Park
