THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HIBERNIAN FC 2023/24) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/188

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Hibernian FC 2023/24) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023”. The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - (a) "Article" means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“event coach” means any vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers, where said vehicle is in actual use as a private charter to drop off and/or collect supporters attending matches at Easter Road Stadium, Edinburgh;
"Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
"Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;
"road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
 - (b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate public safety and the safe ingress/egress of spectators during Hibernian FC fixtures being held at Easter Road Stadium, Edinburgh (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, with the exception of vehicles associated with the events which are parked under Police direction, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
 - (ii) Article 3(b) shall apply to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge on the sections of **Hawkhill Avenue** (*outside No. 9 only*) and **St Clair Street** described in Schedule 2 hereto.

5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Easter Road, London Road, Marionville Road, Lochend Road South and Lochend Road.

SCHEDULE 1 ROAD CLOSURES

- (A) **between 14:00 hours and 15:15 hours & between 16:30 hours and 17:30 hours** on:
26th August 2023, 23rd September 2023, 30th September 2023, 28th October 2023, 11th November 2023, 2nd December 2023, 16th December 2023, 2nd January 2024, 3rd February 2024, 24th February 2024, 2nd March 2024, 16th March 2024 and 6th April 2024;
- (B) **between 18:45 hours and 20:00 hours & between 21:15 hours and 22:15 hours** on:
1st November 2023 and 7th February 2024; and
- (C) **between 19:00 hours and 20:15 hours & between 21:30 hours and 22:30 hours** on:
27th December 2023 on:
- (i) **Hawkhill Avenue**; (ii) **Hawkhill Close**; (iii) **St Clair Street**; (iv) **Albion Place**; (v) **Albion Road**; (vi) **Albion Terrace**; (vii) **Albion Gardens**; and (viii) **Harrismith Place**.

SCHEDULE 2 PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

- (A) **between 12:00 hours and 17:30 hours** on:
26th August 2023, 23rd September 2023, 30th September 2023, 28th October 2023, 11th November 2023, 2nd December 2023, 16th December 2023, 2nd January 2024, 3rd February 2024, 24th February 2024, 2nd March 2024, 16th March 2024 and 6th April 2024;
- (B) **between 15:45 hours and 22:15 hours** on:
1st November 2023 and 7th February 2024; and
- (C) **between 16:00 hours and 22:30 hours** on:
27th December 2023 on:
- (i) **Albion Road, both sides**, from its junction with Albion Place, eastwards to its junction with Lochend Butterfly Way; (ii) **Albion Place**; (iii) **Hawkhill Avenue** (*except disabled parking bay outside No. 9*); (iv) **St Clair Street, both sides** of its north/south arm (*except blue badge holders*); and (v) **Regent Road, both sides**, between its junction with Carlton Terrace Brae and its junction with Carriage Drive (*except event coaches parked in the designated coach parking bays on the south side*).
