THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (POLWARTH GARDENS AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/208

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Polwarth Gardens Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect from the Second day of October Two thousand and twenty-three up to and including the Third day of May Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate footway reconstruction and street lighting works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on (i) **Polwarth Place**, at its junction with Polwarth Gardens; (ii) **Polwarth Park**, at its junction with Polwarth Gardens; (iii) **Harden Place**, at its junction with Polwarth Gardens; and (iv) **Mertoun Place**, at its junction with Polwarth Gardens; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of (i) **Polwarth Gardens**, from its junction with Merchiston Avenue, south-westwards to the projected west property line of No. 116 Polwarth Gardens; (ii) **Polwarth Grove**, from the projected west property line of No. 87 Polwarth Gardens, south-westwards to the projected south property boundary of No. 12 Polwarth Grove; (iii) **Mertoun Place**, from its junction with Polwarth Gardens, north-westwards for a distance of 28 metres or thereby; (iv) **Harden Place**, from its junction with Polwarth Gardens, north-westwards for a distance of 28 metres or thereby; and (v) **Polwarth Place**, from its junction with Polwarth Gardens, north-westwards for a distance of 28 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: (i) **Polwarth Place**; (iii) **Harden Place**; and (iv) **Mertoun Place** – Polwarth Gardens, Polwarth Crescent and Temple Park Crescent.

7. The following road has no available diversion, where local access will be maintained: (ii)
Polwarth Park.
