## THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MEADOW PLACE ROAD AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/27

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Meadow Place Road Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024". The order shall have effect from the Thirtieth day of January Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Third day of March Two thousand and twenty-four.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for utility installation and carriageway resurfacing works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on **Meadow Place Road**, between its junction with Ladywell Road and its junction with Glasgow Road (A8) (*Drum Brae roundabout*), otherwise than in a *northbound* direction;
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on *both sides* of: (i) **Ladywell Road**, from the extended eastern kerbline of Meadow Place Road, eastwards to the extended western kerbline of Ladywell Court; and (ii) **Meadow Place Road**, between its junction with Ladywell Road and its junction with Glasgow Road (A8) (*Drum Brae roundabout*); and
  - (c) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the road described in column 1 of Schedule 1 so as to make the prohibited turn specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 hereto.

## 4. Nothing in:

- (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles; and
- (ii) Article 3(b) shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
- 6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *one-way restriction* will be by way of Glasgow Road (A8), South Gyle Broadway, South Gyle Access, Bankhead Drive, Broomhouse Road and Meadow Place Road.

7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *prohibited turn* will be by way of Broomhouse Road, Broomhouse Drive and Saughton Road North.
