THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SPECIAL EVENT) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/125

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of an event and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under Sections 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -


1. The Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Special Event) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - “event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by The City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - “road” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
 - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the holding of an event (as signed as affected by the event/s), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of the roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
 - (ii) Article 3(a) shall apply to *event vehicles*
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *prohibition of motor vehicles* will be by way of: (1) **Leith Area** – Baltic Street, Salamander Place, Links Gardens, East Hermitage Place, Hermitage Place, Vanburgh Place, Duke Street, Great Junction Street, North Junction Street and Commercial Street; (2) **Wester Hailes Area** – Hailesland Road and Murrayburn Road; and (3) **City Centre, Canongate, Dumbiedykes and Calton Road areas** – London Road, Leith Walk, York Place, Queen Street, St. Colme Street, Ainslie Place, Great Stuart Street, Randolph Crescent, Drumsheugh Place, Drumsheugh Gardens, Chester Street, Palmerston Place, Torphichen Street, Dewar Place, Morrison Street, Lothian Road, Earl Grey Street, Brougham Street, Melville Drive, Summerhall Crescent, Sciennes, Sciennes House Place, Causewayside, West Preston Street, East Preston Street, Dalkeith Road, Blacket Avenue, Minto Street, Mayfield Gardens, Craigmillar Park, Liberton Road, Gilmerton Road, Kingston Avenue, Old Dalkeith Road, Craigmillar Castle Road, Duddingston Road West and Willowbrae Road.

SCHEDULE 2

PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

(A) *from 06:00 hours to 14:00 hours on 12/07/2024 on:*

(i) **Couper Street, west side**, from the extended northern kerbline of Couperfield, northwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; (ii) **Dock Street, west side**, from the extended northern kerbline of Coburg Street, northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; (iii) **Giles Street, east/north-east side**: (1) from the extended southern kerbline of Spier's Place, southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; and (2) from a point 80 metres or thereby south-east of its junction with Henderson Street,

south-eastwards for a distance of 5 metres or thereby; and (iv) **Wellington Place, east side**, from its junction with John's Place, southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby;

(B) *from 06:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 12/07/2024 on:*

(i) **Chambers Street, central reserve bays only** between its junction with Guthrie Street and its junction with West College Street; (ii) **Guthrie Street, north side of east-west section**, from a point 15 metres or thereby east of the eastern kerbline of the northmost north-south section, eastwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby; (iii) **Stevenlaw's Close, both sides**, from its junction with Tron Square, northwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby; (iv) **Mound Place, north side**, from a point 35 metres or thereby west of its junction with North Bank Street, westwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; (v) **Grassmarket, north side**, from a point 105 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with King's Stables Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; and (vi) **Forrest Road, west side**, between its junction with Lauriston Place and its junction with Candlemaker Road;

(C) *from 00:01 hours on 12/07/2024 to 23:59 hours on 16/07/2024 on:*

(i) **St John Street**; and (ii) **Charteris Place**;

(D) *from 06:00 hours to 18:30 hours on 16/07/2024 on:*

Holyrood Road, north side, from the extended western kerbline of Viewcraig Gardens, eastwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby;

(E) *from 06:00 hours to 12:00 hours on 16/07/2024 on:*

(i) **Windyrig Close, south side**, in its entirety; (ii) **Murrayburn Grove**; (iii) **Murrayburn Green**; (iv) **Murrayburn Gardens**; (v) **Murrayburn Park**; (vi) **Hailesland Gardens**; (vii) **Hailesland Place**; and (viii) **Hailesland Grove**; and

(F) *from 06:00 hours to 19:30 hours on 16/07/2024 on:*

(i) **New Arthur Place, south side**, from its junction with Pleasance, eastwards for a distance of 5 metres or thereby; (ii) **Brown Street, north side**, in its entirety; (iii) **Dumbiedykes Road, south side**, from the point the footway at the rear of the southernmost cul-de-sac of Dumbiedykes Road meets the footpath of Braidwood Gate, eastwards for a distance of 5 metres or thereby; (iv) **Cowgate, north side**, between its junction with Gray's Close and its junction with St Mary's Street; (v) **Gullan's Close, west side**, from its junction with Holyrood Road, northwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby; (vi) **East Market Street, south side**, between its junction with New Street and its junction with Cranston Street; and (vii) **Viewcraig Gardens**.
