### What's happening?



The Council has brought in a team to design the refurbishment of the Craigmillar and Peffermill Court blocks. The proposed works to both the privately owned and Council owned flats include:

- making them more energy efficient (which will make them warmer and cheaper to heat)
- refurbishing the foyer and communal areas to make these safer and more accessible
- improving the surrounding land and dog walking areas.

Over the next few months you'll have the opportunity to make suggestions and give feedback on the proposed designs and improvements.

## When is it happening?

The works are currently being designed by the team, the construction works are planned to commence in November 2023 and are expected be completed before the end of 2024.
