THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (A1 AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/28

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (A1 Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The order shall have effect on the Fifth day of May Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-seventh day of June Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate bridge expansion joint works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall **between 19:30 hours and 06:30 hours DAILY Monday–Sunday**, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **A1** (both carriageways), from the outer kerbline of the roundabout at its junction with The Jewel (*excluding the whole roundabout*), south-eastwards for a distance of 1.3 kilometres or thereby (*including all on/off slips within the area described in this section*).
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the **closure** will be by way of: (i) **A1 south-eastbound** – A199 through Musselburgh until it rejoins the A1; or Milton Road, A6106, The Wisp, A7, Sheriffhall roundabout, Edinburgh City Bypass joining the A1 at Old Craighall; and (ii) **A1 north-westbound** – Newcriaghall Road, Duddingston Park South, Milton Road and Milton Link.
