THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CRAIGS ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/56

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Craigs Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025". The Order shall have effect on the Fifth day of May Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirty-first day of March Two thousand and twenty-six.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; "the 2025 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for carriageway resurfacing and the installation of new traffic islands (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on

both sides of **Craigs Road**: (1) from its junction with Maybury Road eastwards to its junction with East Craigs Rigg; and (2) from its junction with Maybury Road, westwards for a distance of 85 metres or thereby.

- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the closures will be by way of: (1) Craigs Road Maybury Road, Glasgow Road (A8), Craigs Gardens and Craigs Road; (2) Craigs Road Maybury Road, Turnhouse Road and Craigs Road; or (2) Craigs Road Bradshaw Drive, Amos Crossway, Amos Place and Berry Drive. The alternative route for pedestrians will be by way of: (1) Craigs Road Craigs Road, East Craigs Rigg and Maybury Road.
