THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (QUEENSFERRY CRUISE LINER VISITS) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/58

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Queensferry Cruise Liner Visits) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The Order shall have effect on the Seventh day of May Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Ninth day of October Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “bus” means a public service vehicle provided that the said vehicle or vehicles are not being operated as a Local Service (as the same is defined in the Transport Act 1985);
 - “cruise liner bus” means any bus authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the Queensferry cruise liner visits;
 - “Chief Constable” means the Chief Constable of the Police Authority for Police Scotland;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - “public service vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981, and, for the purposes of this Order, applies where the said vehicle or vehicles are being operated as a Local Service, as defined in the said Act;
 - “road” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this Order, includes part of a road;
 - “the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate Queensferry cruise liner visits, (as signed as affected by the cruise liner visits), no person shall:-
 - (a) except with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to enter into, remain, proceed in or on any part of any length of road described in Schedule 1; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of any length of road described in Schedule 2.
4. Nothing in:
 - (a) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles; and
 - (b) Article 3(a) shall apply to cruise liner buses or public service vehicles.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the prohibition of vehicles will be by way of Bankhead Road, B924 and Main Street (Dalmeny).

SCHEDULE 1 PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES

From 11:00 hours to 15:00 hours on:

07/05/2025, 18/05/2025, 29/05/2025 and 30/05/2025;
03/06/2025, 11/06/2025, 15/06/2025, 21/06/2025, 23/06/2025 and 26/06/2025;
01/07/2025, 05/07/2025, 15/07/2025, 17/07/2025, 24/07/2025 and 29/07/2025;
22/08/2025, 26/08/2025 and 27/08/2025;
02/09/2025, 06/09/2025, 11/09/2025, 24/09/2025 and 25/09/2025;
06/10/2025 and 09/10/2025.

Bankhead Road: all that part of the carriageway from the extended south kerbline of Station Road (Queensferry) southwards to a point 75 metres or thereby north of the extended north kerbline of Gospatric Gardens.

SCHEDULE 2 PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

(a) from 05:00 hours to 10:30 hours on:

01/07/2025, 05/07/2025, 15/07/2025, 17/07/2025 and 29/07/2025;
22/08/2025, 26/08/2025 and 27/08/2025;
02/09/2025, 06/09/2025, 11/09/2025, 24/09/2025 and 25/09/2025;
06/10/2025 and 09/10/2025;

(b) from 05:00 hours to 12:30 hours on:

29/05/2025; and

(c) from 05:00 hours to 11:15 hours on:

26/06/2025; and

24/07/2025.

Newhalls Road, North Section (Hawes Car Park)

(north side)

From a point 62 metres or thereby west of the extended west building line of 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn), westwards for a distance of 103 metres or thereby.

(south side)

From a point 49 metres or thereby west of the extended west building line of 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn), westwards for a distance of 115 metres or thereby.

(d) **from 05:00 hours to 21:00 hours** on:

07/05/2025, 18/05/2025 and 30/05/2025;
03/06/2025, 11/06/2025, 15/06/2025, 21/06/2025 and 23/06/2025;
01/07/2025, 05/07/2025, 15/07/2025, 17/07/2025 and 29/07/2025;
22/08/2025, 26/08/2025 and 27/08/2025;
02/09/2025, 06/09/2025, 11/09/2025, 24/09/2025, 25/09/2025; and
06/10/2025 and 09/10/2025; and

(e) **from 05:00 hours to 23:59 hours** on:

29/05/2025;
26/06/2025; and
24/07/2025.

Newhalls Road, North Section (Hawes Car Park)

(north side)

From a point 14 metres or thereby west of the extended west building line of 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn), westwards for a distance of 38 metres or thereby.

Newhalls Road/Hawes Brae

(north side and north-east side)

From a point 39 metres or thereby east of the extended west building line of 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn), eastwards and then south-eastwards to the extended south-east kerbline of the vehicular access leading to the rear of number 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn).

(south side and south-west side)

From the extended west building line of 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn) eastwards and then south-eastwards to a point 13.5 metres or thereby south-east of the extended south-east kerbline of the vehicular access leading to the rear of number 7 Newhalls Road (Hawes Inn).
