## Statement of Reasons - TRO/24/17

Electric vehicle chargers support the Council's ambition to be net zero by 2030 and directly support the <u>City Mobility Plan</u>, through both the objective to '*Reduce harmful emissions from* road transport' and the Cleaner Vehicles policy to '*Encourage the switch to cleaner vehicles by* supporting the growth of electric vehicle infrastructure, including the development of a citywide charging network, and monitoring progress in other low and zero emission technologies'.

Shared mobility through car club vehicles similarly supports the Council's ambition to be net zero by 2030 and the <u>City Mobility Plan</u>, through fulfilling a range of objectives, notably '*Maximise the efficiency of our streets to better move people and goods*' and the shared mobility policies of 'Support the expansion of shared mobility options across the city and maximise their integration to support the broader public transport system' and 'Strengthen partnerships with car sharing partners to support the shift to zero emission vehicles and the introduction of new technology to improve safety, standards and accessibility'.
