## THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BUCCLEUCH PLACE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/78

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Buccleuch Place) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025" and shall have effect on the second day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the eleventh day of July Two thousand and twenty-five.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable of the Police Authority for Police Scotland; "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; "the 2025 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
  - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate Scottish Water lead renewal works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven otherwise than in a west to east direction on **Buccleuch Place** between Buccleuch Place Lane and Buccleuch Street; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **Buccleuch Place** (1) (south side); and (2) (centre of carriageway) from the north-west kerbline of Buccleuch Street south-westwards to the south-east kerbline of Buccleuch Place Lane.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Buccleuch Street, Chapel Street, Crichton Street, George Square, George Square Lane, Meadow Lane and Buccleuch Place.
