THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (DUNCAN STREET) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/89

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Duncan Street) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025" and shall have effect on the ninth day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the eighteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-five.
- In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 "the 2025 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
 "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate Scottish Water valve repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on **Duncan Street** at its junction with Minto Street; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **Duncan Street** from the south-west kerbline of Minto Street south-westwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
- 6. The Corporation of Edinburgh (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, and Parking Place) Order 1973, Schedule 3, will be suspended in relation to the one-way street on Duncan Street, between Upper Gray Street and Minto Street.

7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of South Gray Street, West Mayfield and Minto Street.
