THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ASSEMBLY FESTIVAL ROXBURGH PLACE)  
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 –  
TEMP/25/81

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Assembly Festival Roxburgh Place event on and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Assembly Festival Roxburgh Place) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025” and shall have effect from 8:00 hours on the sixteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including 23:59 hours on the twenty-eighth day of August Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of the Assembly Festival on Roxburgh Place (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of **Roxburgh Place, both sides**, from the south-east kerbline of Drummond Street, south-eastwards for 58 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Drummond Street, Roxburgh Street, West Adam Street and Roxburgh Place.
