



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (WARRENDER PARK ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/97

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Warrender Park Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025” and shall have effect on the fourteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the fourth day of August Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate SGN stub replacement works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on **Warrender Park Road**: (i) at its east junction with Marchmont Road; and (ii) at its west junction with Marchmont Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the closures will be by way of: (i) **Warrender Park Road (east side)** – Marchmont Road, Meadow Place and Marchmont Crescent; and (ii) **Warrender Park Road (west side)** – Warrender Park Terrace, Spottiswoode Street, Spottiswoode Road and Arden Street.
