THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ARBORETUM AVENUE AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/105

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Arboretum Avenue Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The Order shall have effect on the Twenty-eighth day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Fourteenth day of September Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for Scottish Water mains works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of: **Arboretum Avenue** from a point 60 metres or thereby north-west of the extended south-west kerbline of St. Bernard’s Row north-westwards for a distance of 190 metres or thereby; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of: (i) **Arboretum Avenue** (1) from the extended south kerbline of Inverleith Terrace southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby; (2) from a point 60 metres or thereby north-west of the extended south-west kerbline of St. Bernard’s Row north-westwards for a distance of 190 metres or thereby; (ii) **Arboretum Place** from the extended south kerbline of Inverleith Terrace northwards for a distance of 105 metres or thereby and (iii) **Inverleith Terrace** from the extended east kerbline of Arboretum Place eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.



6. The alternative route for through general vehicular traffic with respect to the **closure** of **Arboretum Avenue** will be by way of: Arboretum Avenue, Inverleith Terrace, Inverleith Row, Brandon Terrace, Glenogle Road, Bridge Place and Arboretum Avenue.
