THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (GREENDYKES ROAD, SOUTH-WEST LEG) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/114

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Greendykes Road, South-West Leg) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025". The Order shall have effect on the Fourth day of August Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirtieth day of September Two thousand and twenty-five.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for Robertson Civil Engineering to carry out new foul Manhole (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of:

**Greendykes Road (south-west leg), both sides,** from the north-west kerbline of Pringle Street, north-westwards to the south-east kerbline of Greendykes Drive.

- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the *road closure* of **Greendykes Road (south-west leg)** will be by way of Greendykes Road (south-west leg), Greendykes Road (north-east leg), Tudsbery Avenue and Greendykes Road (south-west leg).
