



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ROSE STREET SOUTH LANE NO.2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/85

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Rose Street South Lane No.2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025” and shall have effect on the Eighth day of September Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-sixth day of September Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe working area for utility works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on ***both sides of Rose Street South Lane (east and south legs between Frederick Street and Castle Street)*** from the extended south kerbline of Rose Street, southwards for a distance of 24.5 metres or thereby, and then westwards for a distance of 65 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. There is no available diversion with respect to the ***closure of Rose Street South Lane***, where local access will be maintained.
