### THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CANDLEMAKER ROW) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/90

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Candlemaker Row) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The Order shall have effect on the Eighth day of September Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-first day of September Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing and drainage improvement works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of: (i) **Candlemaker Row** (ii) **Merchant Street** at its junction with Candlemaker Row and (iii) **Greyfriars** at its junction with Candlemaker Row; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of: (i) **Candlemaker Row** in its entirety; (ii) **Merchant Street** from the east kerbline of Candlemaker Row eastwards for 40 metres or thereby; and (iii) **Greyfriars** in its entirety.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. ‘The Lothian Regional Council (Marshall Street, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order, 1991’ shall be suspended between **19:00 hours on 08/09/2025 and 06:00 hours on 21/09/2025** in relation to the *prohibition of vehicles* on **Marshall Street**, to permit general vehicular traffic.
7. The alternative route for through general vehicular traffic with respect to the *closure* of **Candlemaker Row** will be by way of: George IV Bridge, Chambers Street, South Bridge, Nicolson Square, Marshall Street, Potterrow, Lauriston Place, Lady Lawson Street, West Port and Grassmarket; and for buses and pedal cycles by way of Grassmarket, West Port, Lauriston Street, Lauriston Place and Forrest Road.

8. There is no available diversion with respect to the *closures* of **Merchant Street** and **Greyfriars**, where local access will be maintained where practical.
