

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 14

The City of Edinburgh Council hereby give notice under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, that for the reason set out in Section 14(1) (b) of that act and to ensure the safety of the public and all those involved in the Scotland Demands Better parade, no person shall:

Drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the carriageway lengths listed below between the times and dates stated below, or as directed by a Constable in uniform (except event related vehicles);
