Replace a shared use parking bay and a 24 hour waiting restriction with a 24 hour waiting restriction and loading prohibition on Valleyfield St; 3. Replace part of a daytime waiting restriction with a 24 hour waiting restriction and loading prohibition on Leven Ter; and 4.
