

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 14

The City of Edinburgh Council hereby give notice under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, that for the reason set out in Section 14(1) (b) of that act and to ensure the safety of the public and all those involved in the Torchlight Procession event, no person shall:

Drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the carriageway lengths listed below between the times and dates stated below, or as directed by a Constable in uniform (except event

related vehicles), diversion by way of adjoining roads:

- d) Is in possession of a valid official pass issued in respect of the Edinburgh's Hogmanay Torchlight Procession and is taking part in, rather than travelling to or from, the event.
