Purpose of Job

Work with Adult Education tutor as a model for various art classes.

Art models may be required to pose unclothed or partially clothed.

Major Tasks

To pose as an art model (draped or undraped) for art classes under the direction of the class tutor.

Job Activities

To work under the direction of the tutor in terms of the poses required.

To hold a pose for a minimum of 10 minutes and a maximum of 20 minutes unless a break is required sooner.

To wear a particular type of garment on occasions if the tutor requests this.

Attend induction and other training as deemed necessary by the Children and Families Department

Supervision and Management of People (Numbers and type of staff)

None.

Creativity and Innovation

Must be prepared to hold a required pose for various/extended periods of time.

Contacts and Relationships

Art Models will normally be recruited for specific sessions by the Community Learning & Development worker or Adult Education Programme Organiser to support art classes.

The model would be required to take direction from the Adult Education class tutor regarding posing for class students.

The model would be required to build effective relationships with class students.

Decisions (Discretion)

The tutor will direct the postholder in the poses required.

Decisions (Consequences)

The art model's work allows students to further their drawing skills.

Resources

The postholder may be required to pose with different costumes or props.

Environment – Work Demands

To follow the instructions of the tutor regarding posing for classes.

Environment – Physical

The postholder can be required to hold a pose for a length of time which will be physically demanding. Maximum length of time to hold a post may be 20 minutes, unless a break is required sooner.

Environment – Working conditions

For life modelling there is the possibility that air temperatures might be variable or less than ideal. Normally additional heating is arranged but the nature of the venue eg classroom, hall can mean that the environment is cold.

No formal experience is required. However, some previous experience of modelling may be an advantage.
