Information on this page may be a useful guide of what to expect on the day of the examination.

1. How long will the assessment last?

a. The assessment will last for 1 hour

2. What do I need to bring with me on the day?

a. Drivers licence and invitation letter (which will be sent to you once we have received this booking form)

3. Is the assessment open or closed book?

- a. The assessment is closed book
- b. You are not permitted to bring any materials/pencil cases/ correction fluid/paper or mobile phones into the assessment room

4. How many questions are in the assessment?

- a. The assessment is split into two halves:
 - i. Part 1 80 questions
 - Will assess your knowledge of landmarks, premises, locations and street awareness.
 - ii. Part 2 5 questions
 - Will assess your route knowledge through the city and require you to identify how you would convey fare paying passenger by the 'shortest practicable route' between two points

5. What is the pass mark for the assessment?

- a. The pass mark for the assessment is:
 - i. Part 1 72 out of 80
 - ii. Part 2 4 out of 5

6. Are there past papers available?

a. As topographical assessment take place several times throughout the year, we do not provide past papers

7. How long will the assessment take to mark?

a. Assessment papers will usually be marked within 1 week of the test date

8. How will I receive my results?

a. Results will be emailed to you using the email address provided on the booking form or posted to your home address.
