THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BURDIEHOUSE CRESCENT) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/43

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Burdiehouse Crescent) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the Eighteenth day of March Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the Ninth day of July Two thousand and twenty-seven.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a construction site compound (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of **Burdiehouse Crescent**, from its south junction with Burdiehouse Street, eastwards and then north-eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the *road closure* of **Burdiehouse Crescent** will be by way of Burdiehouse Street and Burdiehouse Crescent (*north junction with Burdiehouse Street*).
