Experience requirements

ESSENTIAL

1. Substantial operational experience in children’s social work services.
2. Considerable experience in child protection and risk assessment.
3. Considerable experience in working with children who are looked after and accommodated.
4. Considerable experience in permanency planning for looked after and accommodated children.
5. Experience of taking a lead role in developing a service/practice in a social services setting.
6. Experience working with and maintaining electronic databases.
7. Experience of managing, supervising or mentoring social work personnel.
8. Experience of chairing meetings
9. Experience of managing change processes in organisations
10. Experience of Partnership working

DESIRABLE

1. Experience of working with high-risk vulnerable pregnant women
2. Experience of evaluating impact, outcomes and data analysis
3. Experience of leading on strategic recommendations for practice

ESSENTIAL

1. Establish a lead role in building and maintaining team by providing support, supervision and leadership.
2. Ensure the allocation of budget is appropriate and meets the needs of service users.

3. Ability to maintain high practice standards in a culture of responsiveness to changing needs of children and families
4. Ability to plan and monitor services and prioritise and co-ordinate cases.
5. Ability to monitor and analyse performance and a strong commitment to performance improvement.
6. An ability to lead a team working within a collaborative of numerous agencies.
7. An ability to work on a partnership basis
8. Ability to initiate and develop new ideas and approaches to meet the needs of children and families, in line with identified outcomes.
9. Ability to keep abreast of changes with regard to policies, legislation and guidelines, both locally and nationally.
10. Ability to understand issues and problems, to analyse and assess complex situations, often within limited timescales
11. Ability to work with challenging families, where there are complex needs.
12. Ability to work with service users who are resistant to intervention and may be aggressive or uncooperative.
