

The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, and Parking Places) and (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Order 202\_ - **TRO/25/56**

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, to **1.** Introduce an exemption for pedal cycles to the existing one way restriction (East to West direction) on Glengyle Ter; **2.** Introduce an exemption for pedal cycles to the existing one way restriction (North to South direction) on Leven Ter; **3.** Introduce a one way restriction (South to North direction), with an exemption for pedal cycles, on Drumdryan St; and **4.** Replace daytime waiting restrictions with 24 hour waiting restrictions on Leven Ter.
