THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MORNINGSIDE DRIVE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/29

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Morningside Drive) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” and shall have effect on the third day of April Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the twentieth day of April Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the installation of a zebra crossing (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on any part of **Morningside Drive** at its junction with Comiston Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **road closure** will be by way of **Morningside Drive** – (1) Morningside Drive, Craighouse Road, Craighouse Gardens, Balcarres Street, Belhaven Terrace and Comiston Road; and (2) Morningside Drive, Morningside Grove, Greenbank Drive, Greenbank Terrace and Comiston Road.
