THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (PLEASANCE AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/45

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Pleasance Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the Twentieth day of April Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirty-first day of July Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate footway and carriageway resurfacing and improvement works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, during the times and dates specified in the said Schedule; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, during the times and dates specified in the said Schedule, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the road unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **road closures** of : (i) **East Adam Street** will be by way of East Adam Street, West Adam Street, Richmond Place, West Richmond Street and Pleasance; (ii) **Gilmour Street** will be way of Gilmour Street, Simon Square, Davie Street, West Richmond Street and Pleasance; and (iii) **Hardwell Close** will be by way of Hardwell Close, Howden Street, Simon Square, Davie Street, West Richmond Street and Pleasance.

**SCHEDULE 1  
ROAD CLOSURES**

(A) from 00:00 hours on 20/04/2026 to 23:59 hours on 31/07/2026 on:

(i) **East Adam Street**, at its junction with Pleasance; (ii) **Gilmour Street**, at its junction with Pleasance; and

(B) from 00:00 hours on 22/06/2026 to 23:59 hours on 31/07/2026 on:

(i) **Hardwell Close**, at its junction with Pleasance.

**SCHEDULE 2  
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING**

(A) from 00:00 hours on 20/04/2026 to 23:59 hours on 10/07/2026 on:

(i) **Pleasance**, from a point 2 metres or thereby south of the extended north kerbline of Drummond Street, southwards to the extended south kerbline of Brown Street (*including the access road for odd property Nos. 67 to 75*); (ii) **East Adam Street**, from the extended west kerbline of Pleasance, south-westwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby;

(B) from 00:00 hours on 20/04/2026 to 23:59 hours on 31/07/2026 on:

(i) **West Richmond Street**, from the extended west kerbline of Pleasance, westwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby;

(C) from 00:00 hours on 22/06/2026 to 23:59 hours on 31/07/2026 on:

(i) **Pleasance**, from the extended south kerbline of Brown Street, southwards and then south-eastwards to the extended north kerbline of East Crosscausway; and (ii) **Gilmour Street**, from the extended west kerbline of Pleasance, south-westwards for a distance of 24.5 metres or thereby.
