



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (NEWTFT STREET) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/68

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Newtoft Street) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” and shall have effect on the Twenty-seventh day of April Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the tenth day of May Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate drainage connection works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:
(a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on any part of **Newtoft Street (access road to Nos. 41a to 41d)**, at its junction with Newtoft Street (main carriageway); and
(b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides of Newtoft Street (access road to Nos. 41a to 41d)**, from the extended south-east kerbline of Newtoft Street (main carriageway), south-eastwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. There is no available diversion with respect to the **road closure of Newtoft Street (access road to Nos. 41a to 41d)**, where local access will be maintained where practical.
