THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (GYLEMUIR ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/78

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Gylemuir Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the Eighteenth day of May thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirtieth day of October Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. To facilitate Scottish Water sewage works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall walk or cause or permit any person to walk on any part of the footway on **Gylemuir Road**, from a point 16 metres or thereby north of the extended north kerbline of Gylemuir Road, northwards for 46 metres or thereby.
3. The alternative route for pedestrian traffic in relation to the *footway closure* of **Gylemuir Road** will be by way of Gylemuir Road, Meadow Place Road & Glasgow Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained where practical.
