THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (COMMERCIAL STREET & SHORE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/73

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Commercial Street & Shore) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the eighth day of June Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the third day of July Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate footway reconstruction works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on: (i) **Commercial Street** (*both sides*) from the extended north-west kerbline of Shore, north-westwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby; and (ii) **Shore** (*north-west side*) from the extended north-east kerbline of Commercial Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.
4. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3 of this Order.
5. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
