Welcome to the second edition of the Craigmillar and Peffermill Court Refurbishment Newsletter. We want to keep you informed on the progress over recent months and provide the details for the next consultation session.

### What has happened so far?

Since the last issue of the tenant newsletter, the Council's team have been progressing the design proposals for the refurbishment of the blocks and the wider landscape. In order to gather your input on the design, consultation sessions were held on 16<sup>th</sup> January and 13<sup>th</sup> February. The team have worked hard to include this feedback within the design. There has also been engagement with key authorities such as Planning, Building Control, Scottish Fire & Rescue Service and CEC teams to ensure the design is safe and meets everyone's needs.

There has also been a number of surveys carried out to ensure that the design team have the information required to pick up all of the necessary upgrades to the blocks. Thank you for your patience while these survey works have been carried out.

### Next Steps

The works are continuing to be designed by the team, survey works will continue to progress. We aim to have the design process finished by October 2023.
