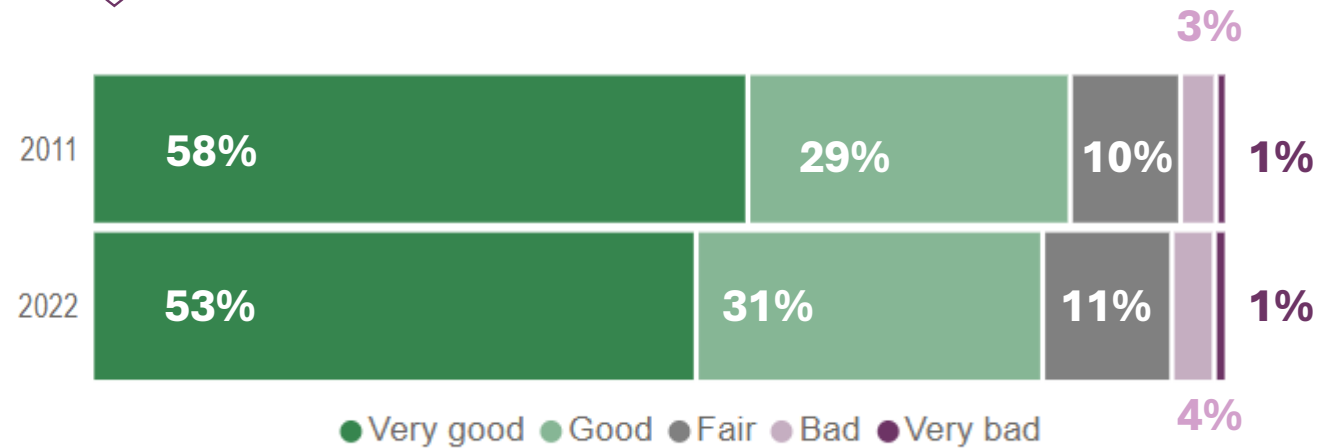

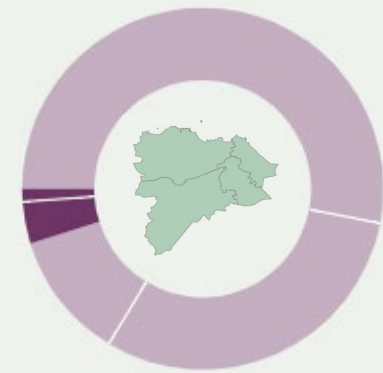

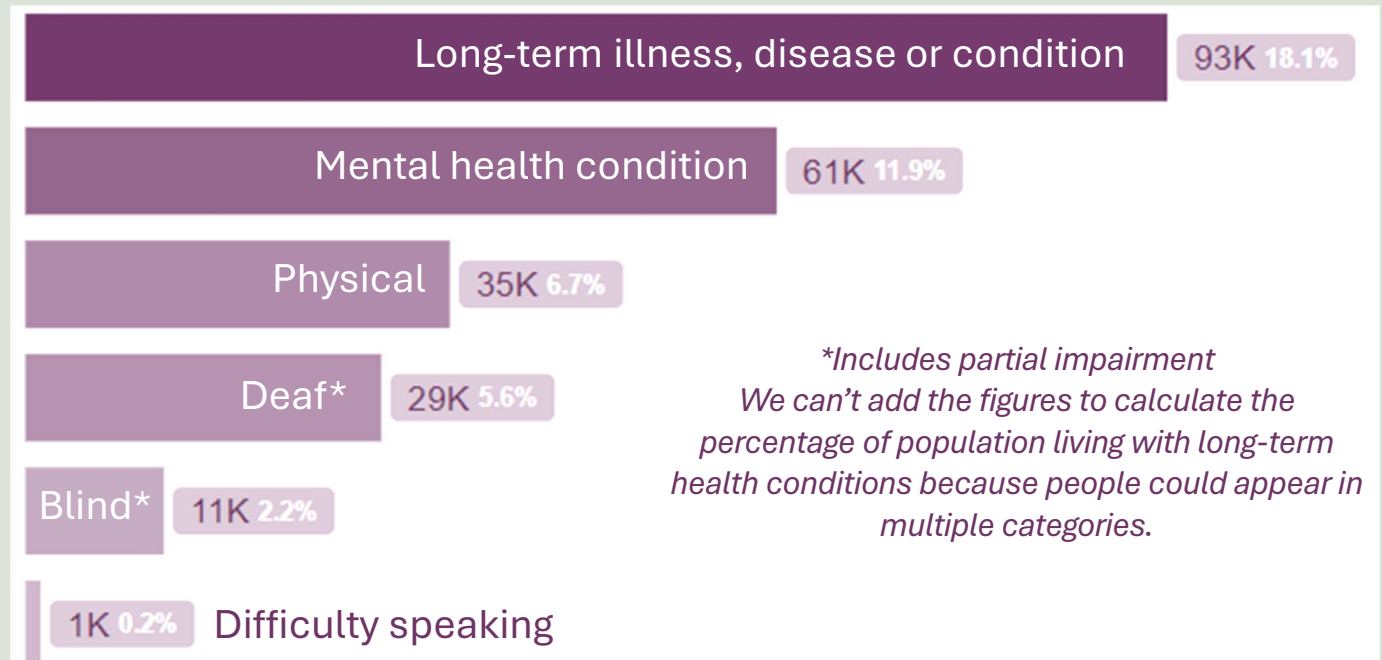

Long-term health conditions in Edinburgh in 2022

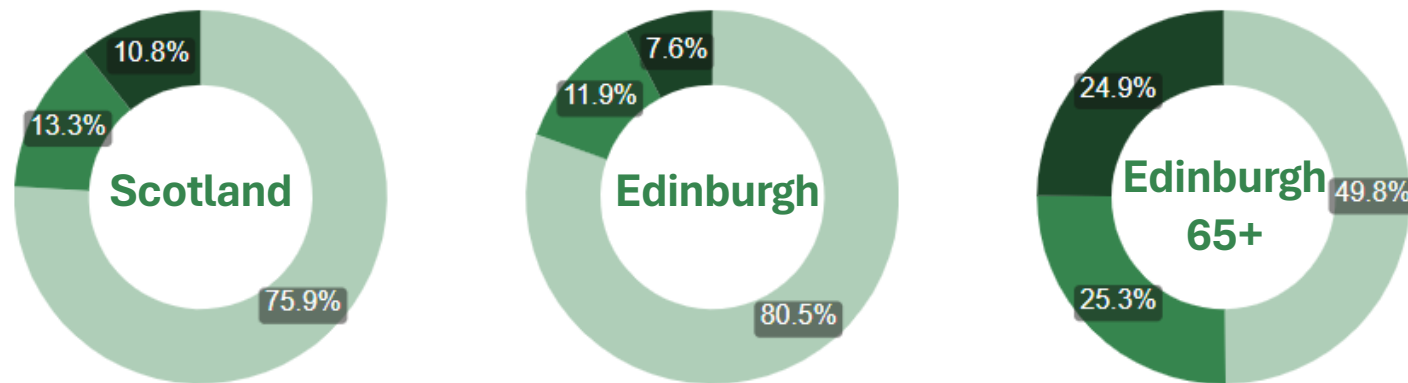

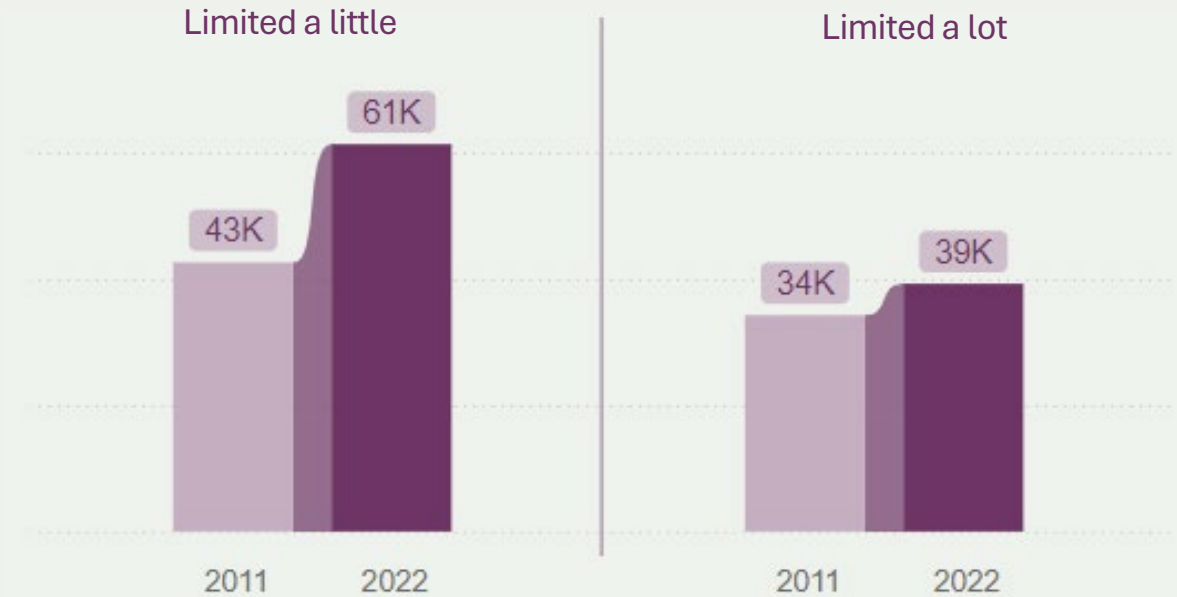

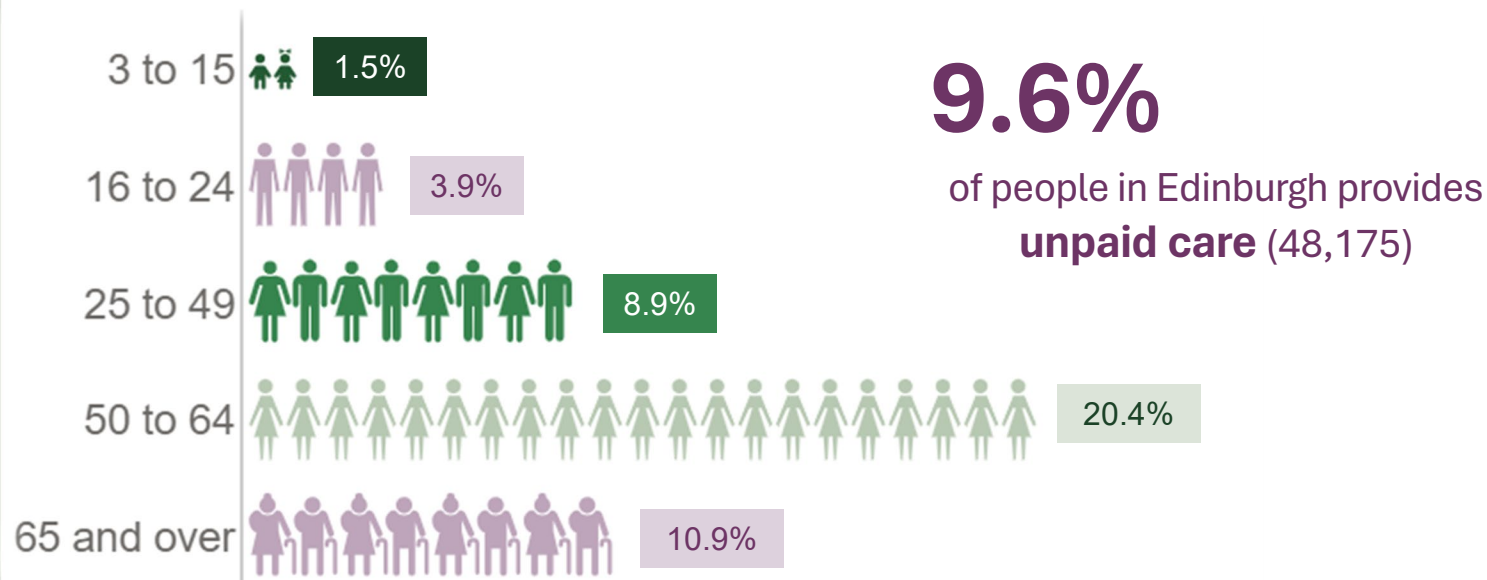


More than 50% of people aged 65 or over in Edinburgh have some limitation when carrying day-to-day activities.

The population in Edinburgh who have their day-to-day activities limited has **increased by 3%** for **small limitations** and **0.4%** for **big limitations** from 2011.

64% of Edinburgh residents who provide unpaid care do it for **less than 20 hours**
