THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CORBIEHILL ROAD AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/96

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Corbiehill Road Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” and shall have effect on the eighth day of July Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the fourteenth day of August Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4 and 5 of this Order, to facilitate footway widening (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on any part of (i) **Corbiehill Road (Access Road to Davidson’s Mains Primary School car park)** at its junction with Corbiehill Road; (ii) **Corbiehill Park** at its junction with Corbiehill Road; and (iii) **Vivian Terrace (south leg)**, at its junction with Corbiehill Road.
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of: (i) **Corbiehill Road, north-east side**, from a point 14 metres or thereby south-east of the extended south kerbline of Vivian Terrace (north leg), south-eastwards to a point 12 metres or thereby north-west of the extended north kerbline of Vivian Terrace (south leg); and **south-west side**, from a point 10 metres or thereby south-east of the extended south-east kerbline of Corbiehill Crescent, south-eastwards to a point 29 metres or thereby south-east of the extended south-east kerbline of Corbiehill Park; (ii) **Vivian Terrace (north leg), north side**, from a point 21 metres or thereby east of the extended north-east kerbline of Corbiehill Road, eastwards for a distance of 17 metres or thereby; and **south side**, from a point 16 metres or thereby east of the extended north-east kerbline of Corbiehill Road, eastwards for a distance of 17 metres or thereby; (iii) **Vivian Terrace (south leg), north side**, from a point 12 metres or thereby east of the extended north-east kerbline of Corbiehill Road, eastwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby; and **south side**, from a point 18 metres or thereby east of the extended north-east kerbline of Corbiehill Road, eastwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.
4. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
5. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.

6. There is no available diversion with respect to the *road closures* of **Corbiehill Road (Access Road to Davidson's Mains Primary School car park)** and **Corbiehill Park**, where local access will not be maintained.
7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the *road closure* of **Vivian Terrace (south leg)** will be by way of Vivian Terrace (north leg).
