THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (DUBLIN MEUSE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/106

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Dublin Meuse) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” and shall have effect on the Sixth day of July Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the twenty-fourth day of July Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe working area for Scottish Gas to carry out gas connection works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on **both sides** of **Dublin Meuse** from the extended west kerbline of Dublin Street, westwards for a distance of 44.5 meters or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **road closure** of **Dublin Meuse** will be by way of Dublin Street, Drummond Place and Nelson Street.
