THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SOUTH COLLEGE STREET) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/98

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate a safe working area for loading and unloading equipment for the holding of the Edinburgh International Festival and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (South College Street) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the second day of August Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the thirty-first day of August Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for loading and unloading equipment (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of: **South College Street, north side**, from the extended east kerbline of West College Street, eastwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3 of this Order.
