THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CRAIGCROOK ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/111

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Craigcrook Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the Third day of August Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the Sixteenth day of August Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“Chief Constable” means the Chief Constable of the Police Authority for Police Scotland;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“road” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this Order, includes part of a road;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate renewal works, (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven, otherwise than in a south to north direction, on any part of **Craigcrook Road** from its junction with Hillpark Drive to its junction with Queensferry Road; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, or load onto or unload from any vehicle on any part of **Craigcrook Road** from the extended south kerbline of Hillhouse Road, southwards to the extended north kerbline of Hillpark Drive.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **one-way** on **Craigcrook Road** will be by way of Hillhouse Road, Strachan Road and Craigcrook Road.
