THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HARRISON ROAD) (NO. 2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/115

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers confer on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Harrison Road) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026”. The Order shall have effect on the thirty-first day of July Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the thirty-first day of October Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate bridge structural repair works, (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of; and
 - (b) walk or cause or permit any person to walk on any part of the footways of;
Harrison Road: (i) from the extended south-east building line of No. 17 Harrison Road, south-eastwards to the extended north-west building line of No. 57 Harrison Road; and
(ii) from the extended north-west kerbline of Polwarth Terrace, north-westwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in:
 - (a) Article 3(a) of this Order shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
 - (b) Article 3(b) of this Order shall prevent any person from walking or causing or permitting any person to walk on the part of the road specified in this Order if the person is there in connection with the works.
5. The following Order, “The City of Edinburgh Council (Harrison Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” is hereby revoked.
6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **road closures** of **Harrison Road** will be by way of: (i) Harrison Road, Slateford Road (A70), Shandon Place, Ashley Terrace, Harrison Gardens and Harrison Road; and (ii) Harrison Road, Polwarth Terrace, Ashley Terrace, Harrison Gardens and Harrison Road.
7. The alternative route for through pedestrian traffic in relation to the **footway closures** of **Harrison Road**, will be by way of Harrison Road, West Bryson Road, Dundee Terrace, Angle Park Terrace, Slateford Road (A70) and Harrison Road.
