THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION NO. __) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 202__ - TRO/26/15

The City of Edinburgh Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 2(3), and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Management) (Variation No. __) Traffic Regulation Order 202__" and shall come into operation on the ____ day of ____ Two thousand and ____ - ____.
2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Management) Traffic Regulation Order 2021, shall have effect subject to the variations, insertions, substitutions and additions thereto specified in the Schedule of this Order.
