



Park Quality Assessments Results 2026

1. Introduction

City of Edinburgh Council has assessed the quality of its parks on an annual basis since 2008 (except in 2020) using Green Flag Award field criteria with the results used to inform strategies and performance indicators, evidence improvement as well as provide parks management with information that should be used to better improve the quality of all its parks.

2. Methodology

2.1. Green Flag Forum

The Green Flag Forum consists of parks management, site managers, key officers and a representative from the greenspace forum that oversees the Park Quality Assessment (PQA) and Edinburgh's Green Flag Award (GFA) programmes.

The forum meets in November each year to discuss the recent PQA and GFA results with a view to identifying local and citywide park improvements. It also agrees on the methodology to be used in the next round of assessments, making changes where necessary but ensuring year on year analysis is retained, sets targets for the Edinburgh Minimum Standard and identifies and approves sites for Green Flag Award submission.

2.2. Green Flag Award

Green Flag Award is the national and fast becoming, international standard for parks and green spaces. The award scheme began in 1996 as a means of recognising and rewarding the best green spaces in the country. It is also seen as a way of encouraging others to achieve the same high environmental standards, creating a benchmark of excellence in recreational green areas.



The scheme is run under UK Government licence by Keep Britain Tidy who use regional operators to deliver the scheme in other countries. In Scotland the scheme is managed by Keep Scotland Beautiful.

Green Flag Awards are given out on an annual basis, and each site must submit an application each year. The scheme also involves a Green Flag Community Award which is to reward quality sites that are managed by the community.

In 2007, the Green Flag Award was trialled in Scotland with Edinburgh taking part along with Dundee. In that year, Edinburgh was successful in achieving two Green Flags (Braidburn Valley Park and Harrison Park).

Since 2011, Edinburgh has participated in the Green Flag Group Award that sees the authority self-assess existing sites annually and declare standards are being maintained. However, these sites will also be subject to full or mystery shop assessments by external Green Flag judges. A peer review also takes place every two years.

The Green Flag Forum agreed that **no new parks** would be submitted in 2026 which would allow managers to time to focus on existing sites.

In July 2026, City of Edinburgh Council was awarded **35** Green Flag Awards, the most for any local authority in the UK. The Friends of Corstorphine Hill Walled Garden were also awarded a Green Flag Community Award for the 17th year running.

The full results of the 2026 Green Flag Awards will be reported separately late autumn.

2.3. Criteria Used

Whilst the Green Flag Award contains both desk and field assessments, the Park Quality Assessment programme is limited to field assessments carried out by Council officers, external partners and members of the community trained in assessing parks using Green Flag Award field criteria. Thus, the final 'Parks Quality Score' (PQS) should not be read as the site's score against the Green Flag Award but can be used for indicative purposes.

Criteria that cannot be judged during a site visit are assessed as a desktop exercise by the site managers using guidance set by the Green Flag Forum. This approach provides a fuller view of a park's quality.

2.4. Assessment Accuracy

To maximise consistency and accurate scoring for each site, assessments were carried out by experienced officers who, in some cases, were also formal Green Flag Award judges. Additional guidance was also included in the assessment documentation which included previous scores and comments along with the a list of improvements carried out since the last assessment.

To allow scrutiny to take place, provisional site results were made available to site managers, as soon as possible following the assessment. This allowed rectification of any clear judging errors before results were finalised.

2.5. Scoring of Criteria

Each individual criterion was scored out of 10 using the table below.

Criteria that did not apply to a particular site – e.g. ‘conservation of buildings or structures’ on a site where no applicable buildings or structures was present – was scored as 0 = ‘not applicable’ and therefore not included in the total score or average calculations.

2.6. Park Quality Score

Park quality scores were calculated by adding together all the criteria scores and dividing the total by the number of applicable criteria resulting in an average score. This score is then multiplied by 100 to obtain a Park Quality Score (PQS) expressed as a percentage. The maximum score available was therefore 100% for each site.

2.7. Park Gradings

In 2009, bandwidths were introduced to accommodate the natural variance of assessors due to the subjective aspect of the assessments with a 10% variance between assessors deemed acceptable. The bandwidths were reviewed in 2018, and the current grade bandwidths are shown below. All previous data has been retrospectively amended to show the data in the new grading format to enable year on year analysis.

2.8. Edinburgh Minimum Standard

In 2009, it was also agreed that there should be a parks quality score that acted as the Edinburgh Minimum Standard (EMS) for parks. As part of the review of bandwidths and gradings in 2018, it was also agreed that a new mark should be set at Grade C (60%+) for all park types.

2.9. Sites

No changes to the list of parks meant that 142 parks were to be assessed in 2026.

2.10. Locality & Management Areas

The PQA performance data has previously been grouped by Localities due to the geographical aspects and historic shared management responsibilities for all sites. With the management of parks now overseen by the Parks & Greenspace Service, this report predominantly provides data grouped by management area to allow closer scrutiny of the data, but some measures continue to be reported by Locality for continuity purposes. It is worth noting that whilst the Botanical Services team maintain all or parts of the grounds in Princes Street Gardens, Saughton Park and Lauriston Castle they are included in the management area results and are not listed separately.

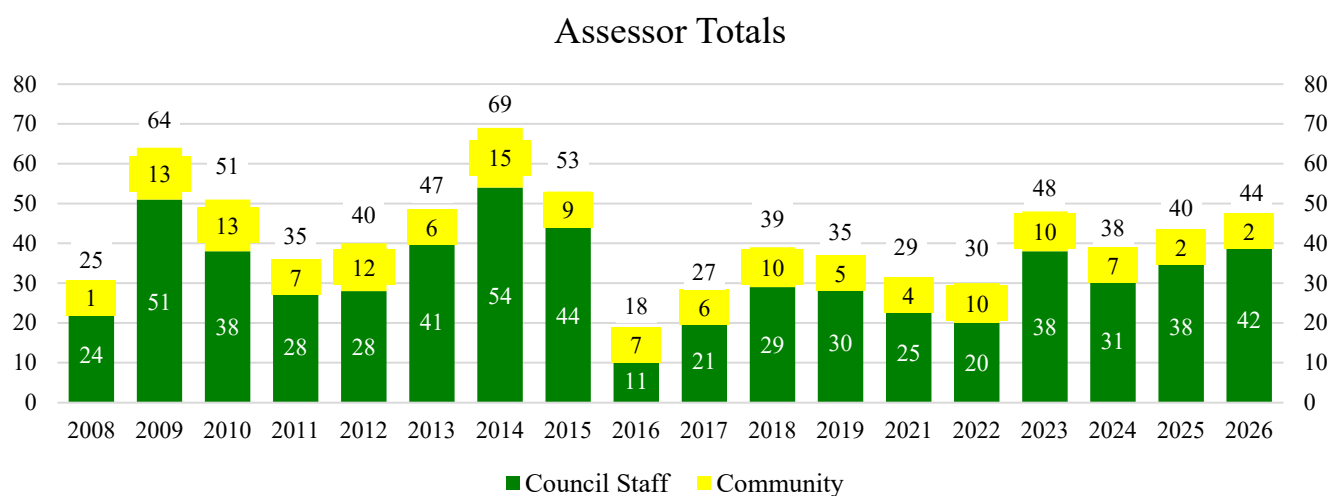
2.11. Judges

Assessments were undertaken by Lead Judges (council officers and community group members) who either assessed the park as a solo judge or with colleagues.

It was agreed at the Forum to try and involve more colleagues in the 2026 assessments to raise awareness and bring some fresh ideas to the park assessments but also to share the workload of assessing 142 parks.

In total, **44** judges were used to carry out the assessments in 2026, four more than last year with nine judging for the first time. Since the first assessments took place in 2008, **231** different judges have taken part with many being involved for two or more years.

The chart below shows the number of assessors taking part each year since 2008.



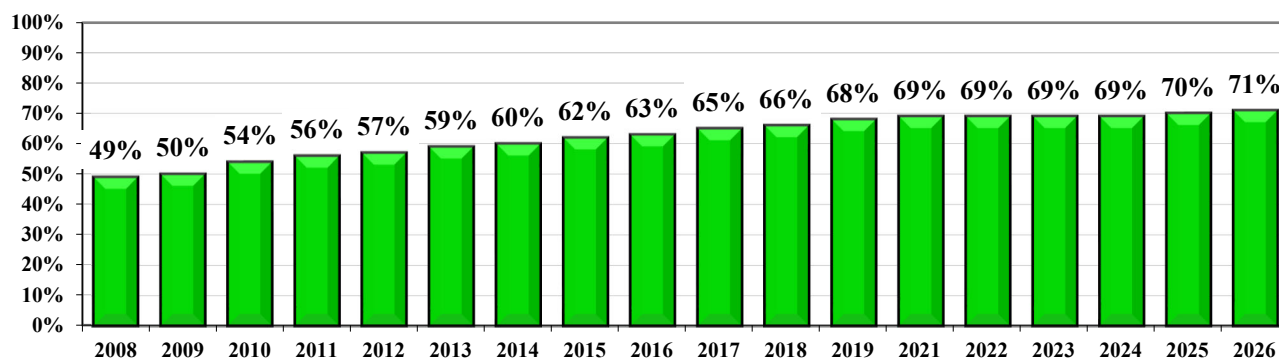
2.12. Assessment Period

In 2008, assessments took place in September/October but the Green Flag Forum agreed to move the assessment period to between mid-April and mid-June so that early season colour provided by bulbs etc were evident, recreation grounds were still being used for sport and the results would fit in with other park deadlines such as budget allocations etc. It also acted as an early warning for parks that were due to be judged as part of the formal Green Flag Award scheme, and we are also able to use PQA as the self-assessments for those parks included in the Green Flag Group Award, which has an end of June deadline.

3. Performance Results

3.1. Park Quality Scores

The chart below shows the average citywide Parks Quality Score for all years.



The tables below show both the **Locality** and **Management Area** average Parks Quality Score since 2022 including the short term (year on year) and long term (current year average compared against the five-year average) trends.

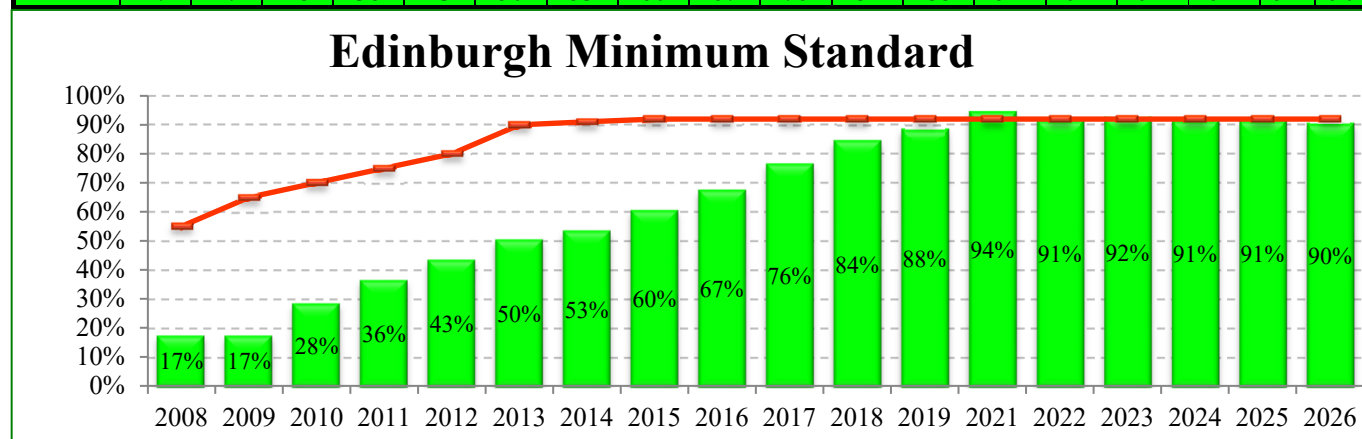
3.3. Edinburgh Minimum Standard

It was agreed that there should be a parks quality score that acted as the Edinburgh Minimum Standard (EMS) for parks, and the percentage of sites meeting the EMS in each Locality has been set as a performance indicator to drive improvement. As part of the 2018 review of bandwidths, the EMS was set at Grade C (60%+) for all park types with data retrospectively amended.

The target percentage of sites meeting the EMS is reviewed by the Green Flag Forum each year and is currently set at **92%**.

Criteria average scores are useful in highlighting which aspects are improving or worsening year on year or over a set period which can then be used to evidence whether strategic actions are having the desired effect.

Over the short term, **12** out of 26 criteria average scores improved whilst **five** fell and longer term, **16** improved and **eight** showed drops.

When comparing against the previous scores in the 142 parks, there were **661** instances where applicable criteria scores improved, **2229** stayed the same and **545** dropped.

This information along with the highlighted actions & recommendations could be used to identify areas where attention is needed most.

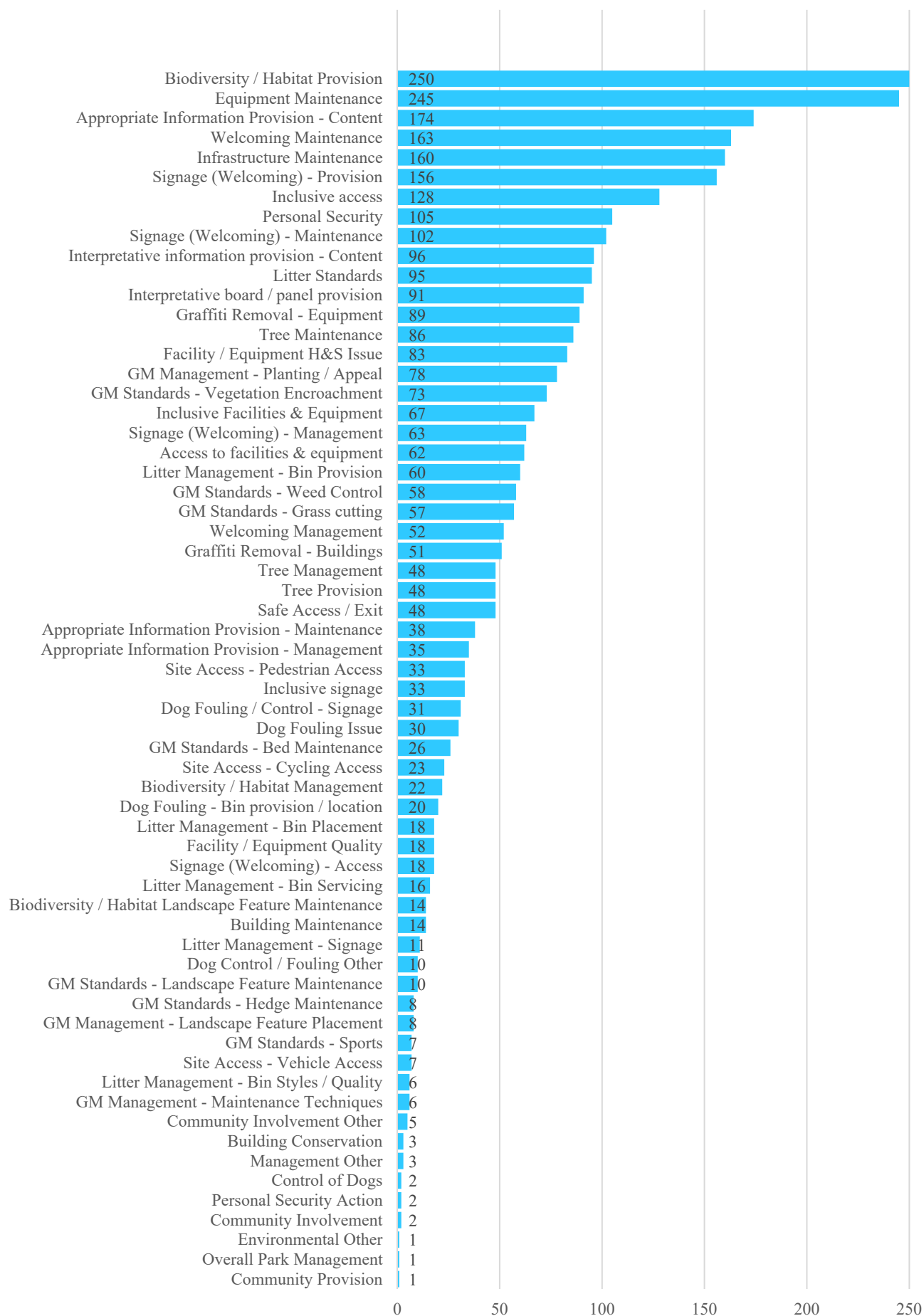

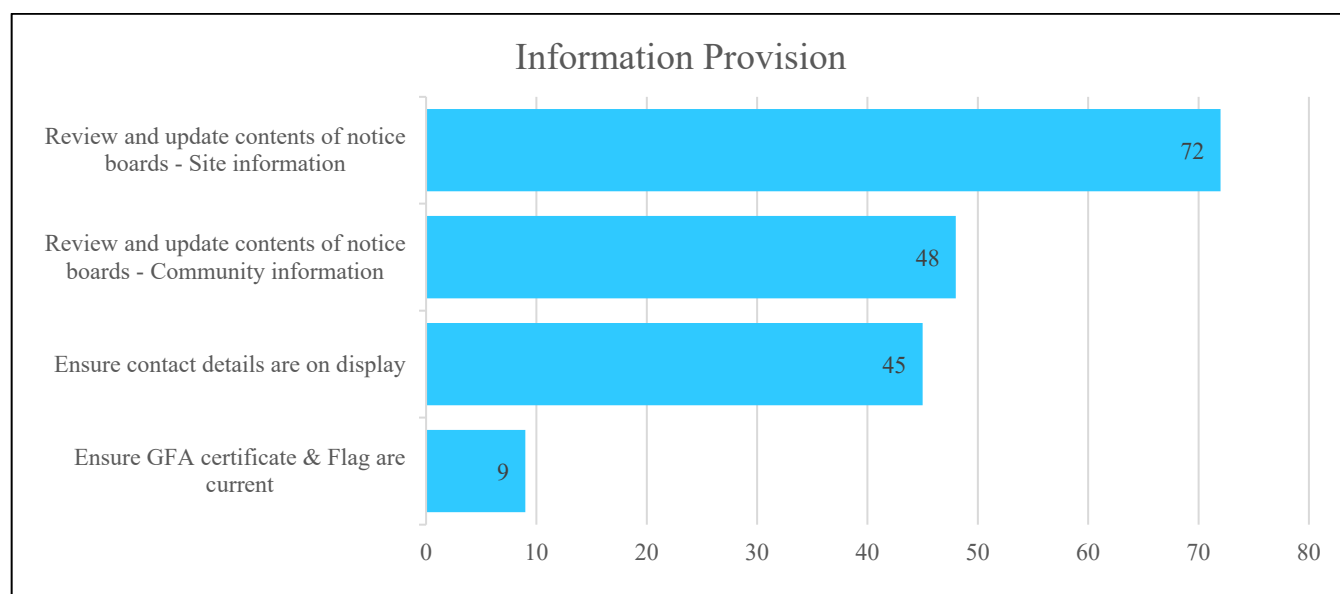
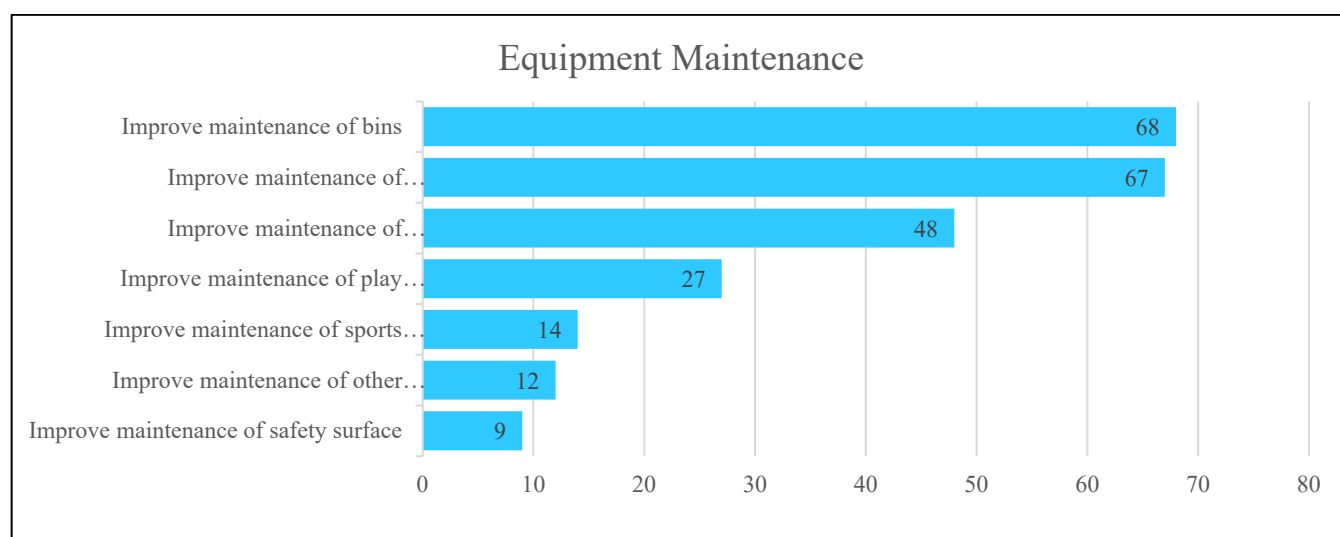
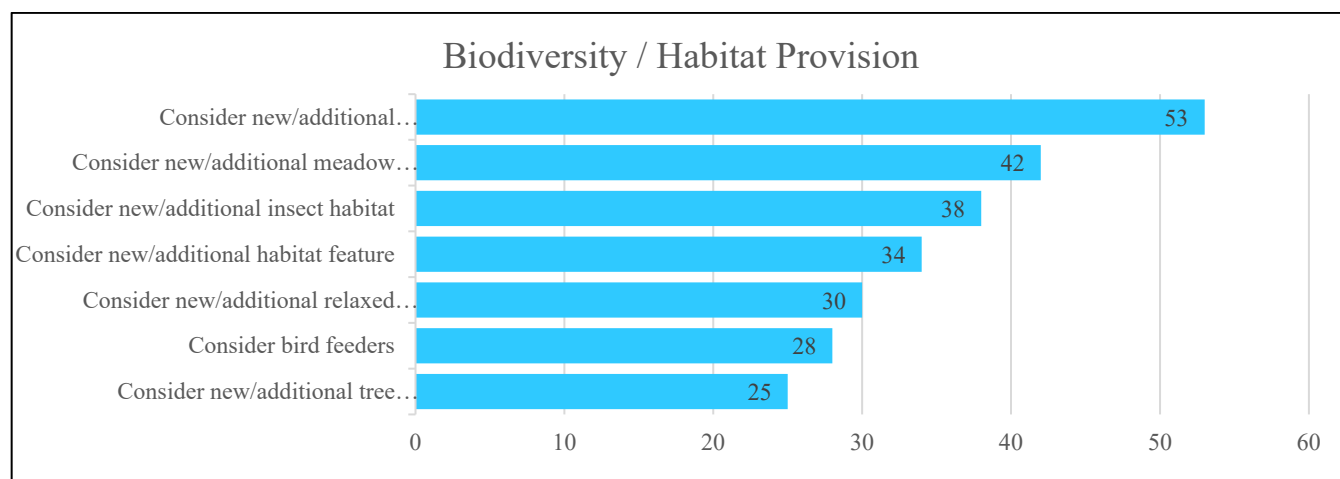
As well as providing scores and three specific recommendations, judges could also suggest specific or general improvement actions which were then allocated a priority level depending on the issue.

3557 site recommendations and actions were identified from the assessments and the chart on the next page shows the total number for each category. The number of actions in the chart shouldn't be read as the number of parks as there may be more than one general action per category.

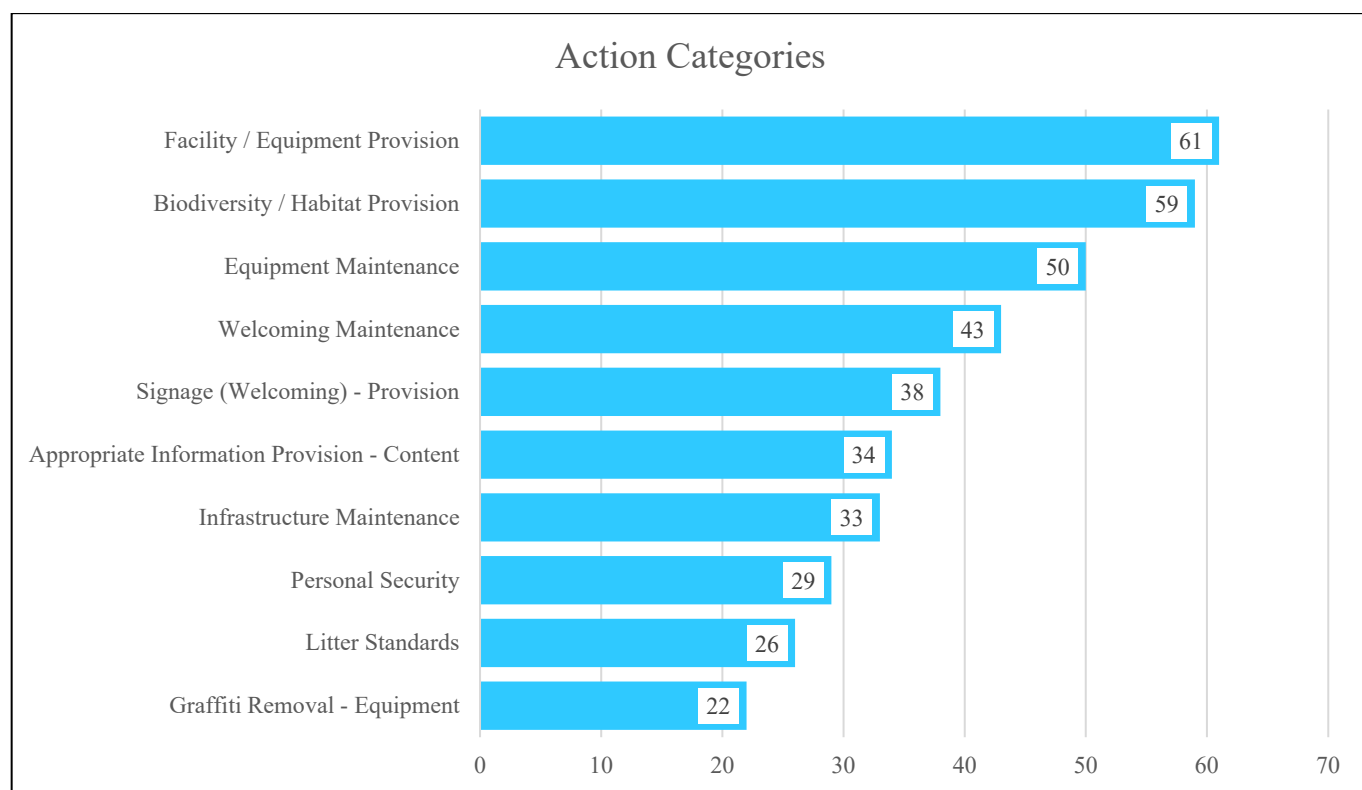

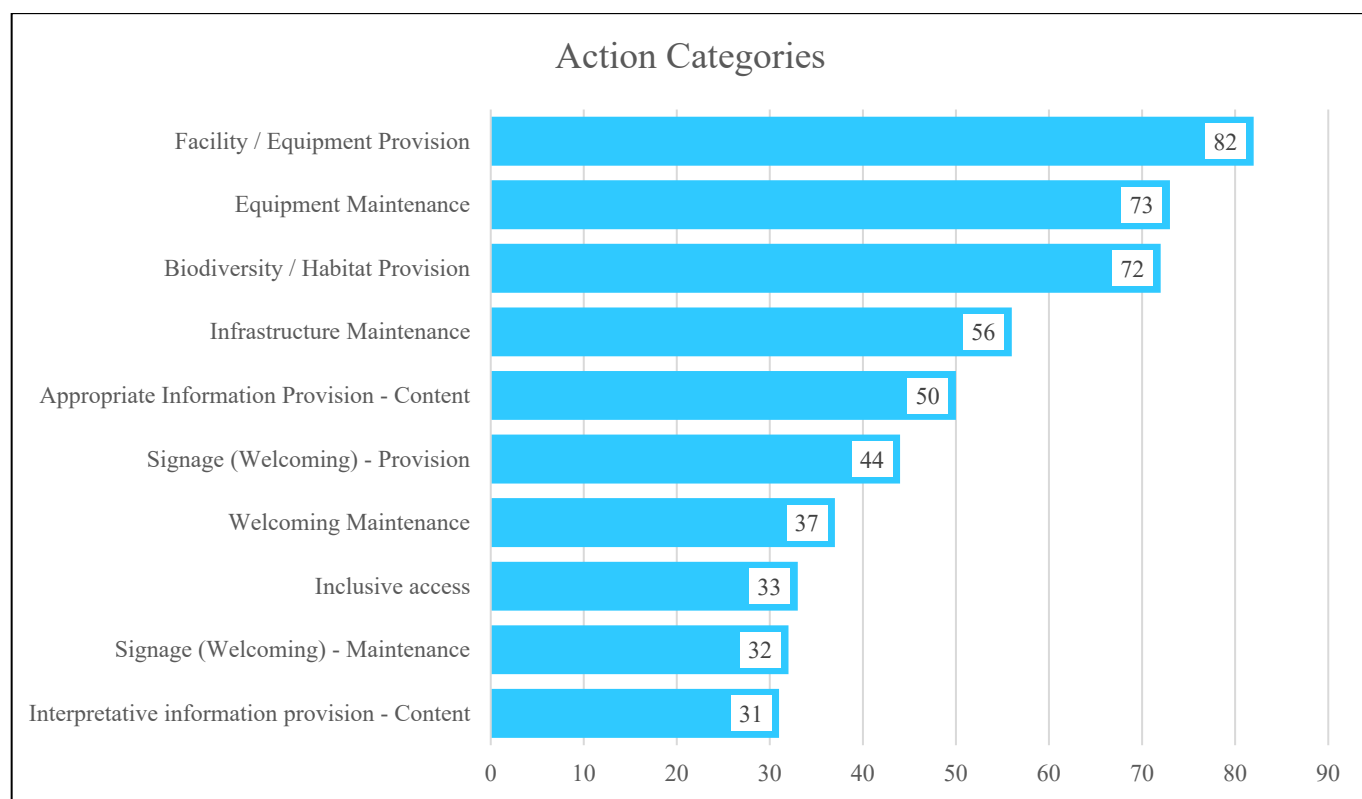

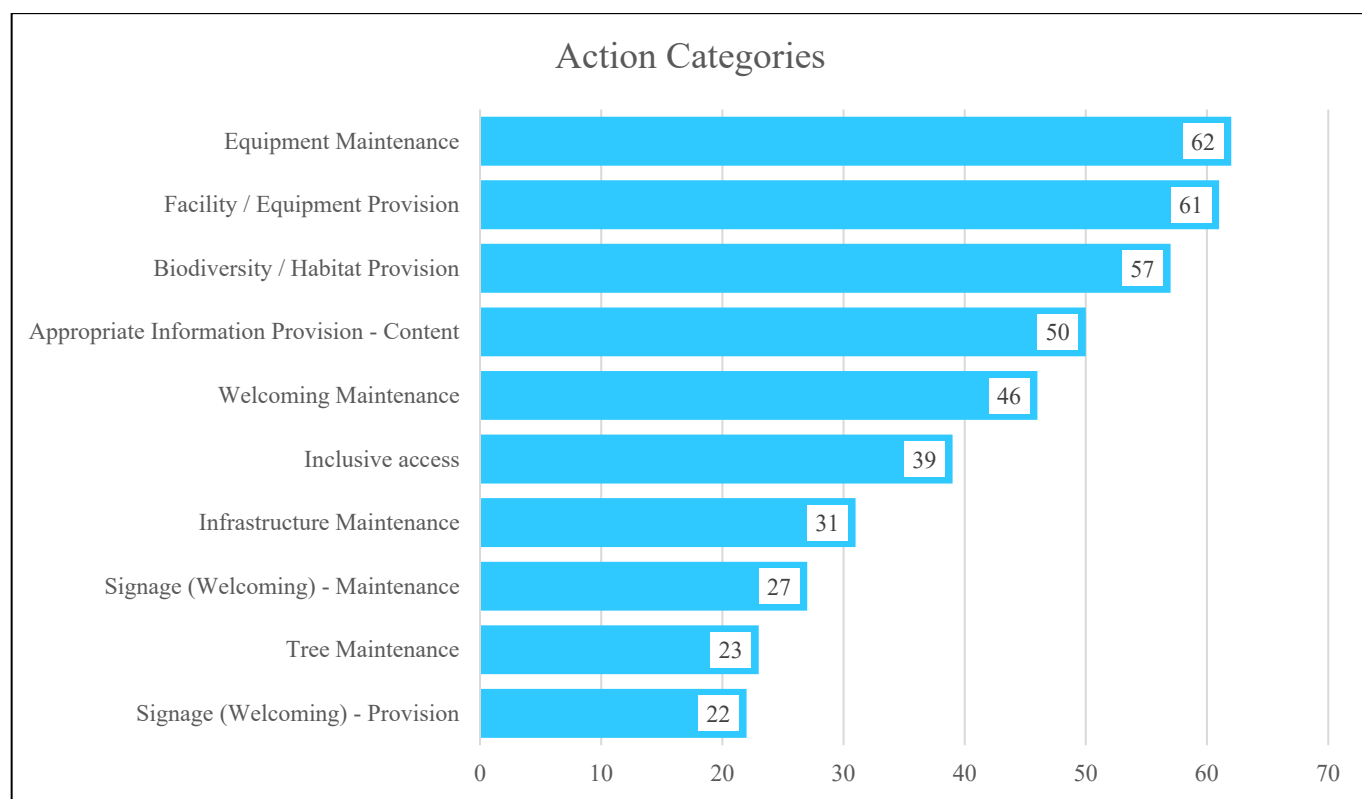

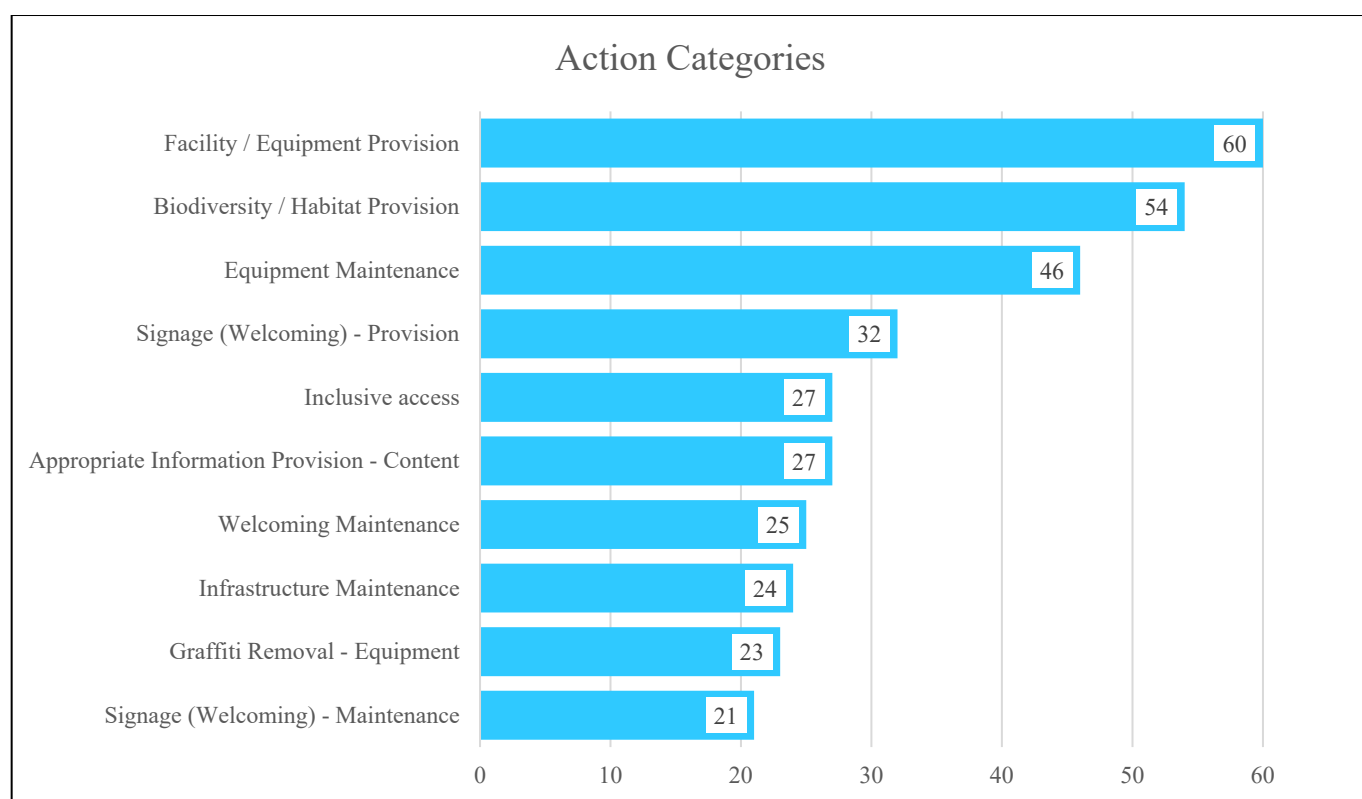

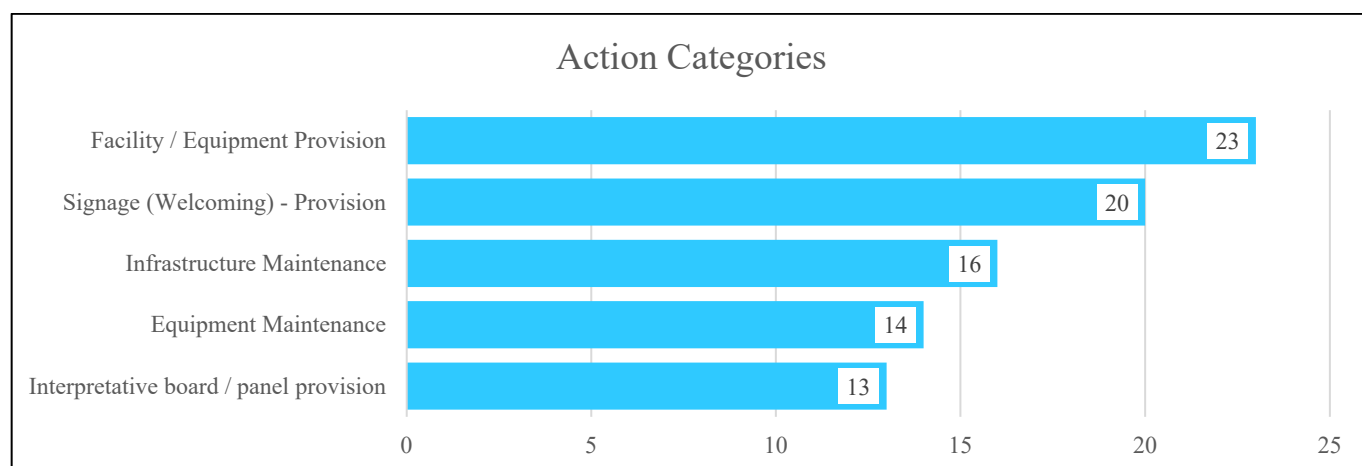
