THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (GREAT KING STREET) (NO.2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026 – TEMP/26/142

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Great King Street) (No.2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2026” and shall have effect from the twenty-first day of September Two thousand and twenty-six and shall remain in force up to and including the eighteenth day of October Two thousand and twenty-six.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate installation of a pedestrian refuge island (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on any part of:
Great King Street, both sides, from the extended east kerbline of Howe Street, eastwards for a distance of 38 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3 of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the **road closure** will be way of: **Great King Street** – Howe Street, Heriot Row, Dundas Street and Great King Street.
